What is a Club Leader?

A Club Leader can be a great help to any Club as they provide a shared role of leadership offering experience and knowledge.

Duties of a Club Leader

As a Club Leader you should:

- Understand the YFC Movement at ALL levels and the democratic principals involved
- Understand the tasks to be fulfilled by Club Officers in order to guide them if necessary
- Be knowledgeable of young people as individuals
- Understand the individuals in the Club and be prepared to listen to them and to treat their comments as confidential
- Have contacts with resource people outside the Club
- Be concerned with the present and the future rather than referring back to the 'good old days'
- Support the Club without being domineering

Remember

Although as a Club Leader you are taking an active role to influence the way in which the Club is run, you do not have a vote at Club Committee Meetings. You must know when to withhold advice to allow Club members to think out problems on their own to ensure that you do not dominate the members.
