

Information Notes for the County Show Secretary

What is the County Show?

WFYFC holds a County Show once a year, usually during May, where each Club within the County competes against one another in various competitions to try and win the County Show trophy.

What does the County Show Secretary do?

It is the responsibility of the County Show Secretary to try and take some of the pressure off the Club Chairman and help to make arrangements for the County Show Competitions.

County Show competitions take place on the actual show day as well as on dates previous, i.e. the Pre-Show Day. It is important that you arrange for suitable people to enter each competition and to ensure that they know the exact dates, times and venues of their competitions.

It is also advisable to try and arrange practices for specific competitions, e.g. stockjudging, flower arranging, poultry boning and jointing, to ensure that you have good entrants.

Where else to go for information?

WFYFC have useful pieces of information that may help you to plan practices and get help with certain competitions. Remember also to ask your Club President, Vice-President(s), Advisory Committee and Club Leader(s) as they may have been YFC members and could be able to offer help and advice. You may also find speaking to other Clubs a good place to find help, as they too will probably be looking for some!
