ALL COMPETITORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE THEIR MEMBERSHIP CARDS. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.
2. Shot Gun Certificates **MUST** be held by all those taking part in the Competition, and **THESE MUST BE PRODUCED AT THE COMPETITION ON ENTRY.** Any person not adhering to the rules will be disqualified. This rule will be strictly enforced by the Stewards.
3. The Activities Committee reserve the right to refuse entries.
4. The Referee's decision will be final.
5. No unsafe Gun to be used
6. One chance only in the final
7. Trapper will show Red Flag
8. Called bird will count in the Final, unless a genuine misfire, subject to referee.
9. No gun to be loaded before taking up firing position. Automatics will be limited to two cartridges.
10. Breach of Gun to remain open until due to fire.
11. Maximum load of cartridge 1.1/8 oz
