

Rules - Club Efficiency Competition 2010-2011

This competition commences in December. The judges visit all Clubs twice, one planned and one surprise visit in no particular order. The Clubs Annual General Meeting will also be taken into account in the judging. The judge will request to see accounts, minutes etc. All Clubs take part in this competition. The results are announced and trophies awarded at the County Annual General Meeting for the Best Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer and Club Efficiency Cups. Judges to consult with County Youth Worker & Coordinator. Club programmes must be sent to judges, and failure to do so may mean that Clubs will not be judged. Scale of Marks are as follows: -

Interim Accounts - 10
Ideas/Enthusiasm etc. - 10
Final Accounts - 10
