Junior Farm Safety Competition

R U L E S

Competition Aim

To encourage members to be aware of on farm safety issues, whilst encouraging teamwork, in a competitive environment.

Learning outcomes

Awareness of farm dangers, understanding, interpretation, team work, first aid and personal development skills.

1. **DATE AND VENUE** – Martin Brook Farm, Lower Town, Claines, Worcs. WR3 7RY, **Sunday, 5th February 2012.**
2. **ELIGIBILITY** – Any current **member** who will be 16 years of age or under on 1 September 2011 and a full member of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC.

Competitors are required *in person* to produce on the day of each round of the competition their current and signed Membership Card, with suitable photo-ID, or a fine of **£10** will be imposed for non-production.

3. **PROCEDURE**
 - a. To design a Farm safety poster using a piece of A4 paper, pens, pencils and/or felt tips. The subject for the poster will be **Dangers from Livestock**. The poster will be completed at the event. Competitors are expected to bring their own pens/pencils and felt tips. Paper will be provided by WFYFC.
 - b. A short quiz on farm safety. This will include hazards associated with tractor reversing, loading or unloading and a lorry with forklift.
4. **TIMING** – Thirty five minutes allowed for completion of the 2 tasks. Maximum of 30 minutes to complete the poster. It will take around 5minutes to complete the quiz/discussion.
